SUBJECT: Request to review the programme of study “*Bachelor of Arts (Hons) Animation and Illustration,*” offered by The Cyprus Academy of Art, via the franchise method, in collaboration with The University of the Creative Arts, UK.

I have instructions to refer to the above subject in response to your letter, dated on October 14th, 2021.

The final review/assessment of the programme of study BA (Hons) Animation and Illustration, which will be offered by your Institution, in collaboration with The University of the Creative Arts, UK via the franchise method, has been completed in compliance with CYQAA’s Law [N. 136(I)/2015 and N.47(I)/2016, article 11].

According to CYQAA’s final review, there is full compliance on your behalf in relation to the conditions set out on the relevant article of the Law.

Therefore, The University of the Creative Arts, UK is permitted to offer the above mentioned higher education qualification/study programme at The Cyprus Academy of Art, via the franchise method.

Regarding the Agency’s recommendation on the academic/teaching personnel, please note that within a period of three months, and no later than December 31st, 2021 you are required to submit to the Agency at least one person among your teaching staff at the rank of Professor or Associate Professor. Furthermore, you are informed that, on the basis of the Article 17(3)(g), in case of no compliance with the Agency’s recommendation, permission to run the above franchise programme will be terminated, and your students will be asked to move to another institution.

The current review commences in the Fall semester of the academic year 2021-2022 and ceases to be in effect at the end of the Spring semester of the academic year 2025-2026.
