SUBJECT: Request to review the programme of study “LL.B Law”, which is offered by the Alexander College Paphos, via the franchise method, in collaboration with the Canterbury Christ Church University, UK.

I have instructions to refer to the above subject in response to your letter, dated on July 1st, 2024.

The final review/assessment of the programme of study **LL.B Law (360 Credits, 180 ECTS, 3 Years Duration)**, has been completed in compliance with CYQAA’s Law [N. 136 (I) / 2015 to 35 (I) 2021], article 11].

As a result, Alexander College (Paphos) is permitted to offer the above mentioned higher education qualification of the Canterbury Christ Church University, UK, via the franchise method.

It should be noted that according to CYQAA Agency’s policy on the academic/teaching faculty members, higher education institutions must select instructors, comprising at least 70% of the total academic staff, who hold a doctoral qualification for all programmes leading to bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees, in combination with the equivalent specialization and expertise in the academic discipline related to the curriculum.

Furthermore, no later than the beginning of the Fall semester 2024-2025, the institute should provide to the Agency, the nominal list of the academic/teaching staff that will be hired by Alexander College (Paphos), and the relevant documentation of their ERGANI payments, as a precondition for running the above franchise programme.

The current review commences in the fall semester of the academic year 2024-2025 and ceases to be in effect at the end of the Spring semester of the academic year 2028-2029.
