Honourable Members of the Council,

**Topic: Application for Evaluation – Accreditation of the new program Bachelor of Design in
(Graphics), (Interior), (Photography), (Fashion).**

We received the External Evaluation Report prepared by the committee after the day visit on the 7th of June 2018 at Alexander College Larnaca. The overall meeting and the report prepared by the committee was very productive for the college. During the program review, the committee examined 107 quality standards and indicators and the following scores were suggested:

1. Applicable to a minimum degree / 0.
2. Applicable to non-satisfactory degree / 15.
3. Applicable to a satisfactory degree / 51.
4. Applicable to a very satisfactory degree / 34.
5. It applies and it constitutes a good practice / 4.

It is important to be mentioned that the proposed degree program is a new program of study incorporating new elements such as research and synergies with teaching (procedures are in place but not implemented yet since the program is under evaluation) and update and new equipment (the college management is committed to further invest upon approval of the course) in order to offer high quality teaching and learning experience amongst students and staff.

After a thorough review of the report prepared by the committee and considering the remarks – suggestions made by the committee the following comments and / or actions will take place in order to improve the overall quality of the program:

- *"Consideration should be given to running four separated Degree Programmes with a shared and improved historical and critical studies programme. This would allow the institution to focus on its strengths, e.g. fashion".*

The College currently offers four separate and individually franchise degree programmes of the University of the West of England, so to accept the first part of this suggestion would be to maintain the status quo. The college's strategy is to gradually come out of the franchised agreement and offer degree programs validated by the Cyprus Agency of Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education. The rationale for a single Bachelor of Design degree as stated in the Report is that it "offers opportunities for co-learning, for collaboration and for interdisciplinary activities". In reality the justification is broader and more fundamental than this and can be summarised under the headings of philosophy, pragmatism and precedent:

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○ Philosophy

- ✓ We believe that there is a new market opening globally, for graduates who can apply knowledge, the ability to insightfully appraise, forensically evaluate, and critically reflect on the utilization of creative methodologies in contextualized applications. From recent debates and discussions with people in the industry, it is evident that the design disciplines are in need of new and fresh ideas to be introduced, as well as expertise in design-based, technological advancements.
- ✓ Young people of today are able to consume disparate media in bites, not chapters; are immersed in the digital and the technological and are able to find, synthesize and apply knowledge in pursuit of ethical solutions. The new course will help them to critically contextualize their skills and values into designing interdisciplinary concepts, either individually or corporately.
- ✓ Interdisciplinary knowledge and understanding is at the nexus of future innovation and it will be through this multiple-perspective innovation that the solutions to 21st Century issues lie. Alexander College can be at the forefront of emerging, creative practices through a Bachelor of Design degree.

○ Pragmatic consideration

- ✓ Running four separate design-based courses, a suggested, means there is inevitably an element of overlap and duplication in core areas which are common to two or more courses.
- ✓ A single, 4 pathway degree will overcome this disadvantage and offer economies of scale, greater efficiency and more consistency of delivery across the four subject specialisms, particularly in the core areas
- ✓ Content is locally developed and delivered. Staff therefore enjoy greater ownership.
- ✓ Students will be able to exchange experiences across the four subject specialisms contributing to better inter-disciplinary understanding and collaboration.

○ Precedent

- ✓ Similar, sample degrees from the following universities were considered in the preparation of our proposal:
 - Goldsmiths University of London (UK)
 - University of Dundee (UK)
 - Edinburgh Napier (UK)
 - Carnegie Mellon (USA)
 - University of Illinois at Chicago (USA)
 - Griffith University (AUS)
 - The University of Melbourne (AUS)
 - Australian National University (AUS)
- ✓ The development of the Bachelor of Design course is in accordance with the "Subject Benchmark Statement for Art and Design February 2017" of the Quality Assurance Agency for Higher Education (QAA) in the UK.

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We strongly believe that the above rationale presents a compelling case for introducing a single Bachelor of Design degree course and would therefore prefer to pursue the second option offered in suggestion No.1 of the Report, namely "to integrate teaching and learning outcomes in a more ambitious way". We currently have 20 core or interdisciplinary modules, 15 pathway specific modules and 3 English modules and will continue to explore methods of enriching the teaching and learning outcomes.

Even though on p. 17 "the panel felt that recent developments in teaching in design (including various pathways), particularly in the theoretical components are not fully reflected in the programme specification", we believe that the input coming from our visiting staff Professor Paul Harris the Dean of Duncan of Jordanstone College of Art and Design at the University of Dundee and Dr. Adonis Frangeskou from the University of the West of England will enrich the theoretical components of the program. Furthermore, the new Research Policy Framework will help the teaching staff to further improve knowledge, understanding and expertise on the components.

It is important to be mentioned that the panel suggested seven out of the nine indicators on Structure and Content of the Program of Study are applicable to a very satisfactory degree. Also, six out of seven indicators on purpose and objectives and learning outcomes of the Program of Study are applicable to a satisfactory degree.

- *"Roll out the research culture into Design. Adopt members of the teaching team and student body onto the Research Centre Scientific Council (and rename this body to reflect its wider remit)".*

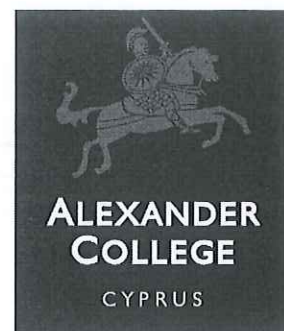
Alexander Research Centre was officially established in 2016. Since its establishment it has worked in close collaboration with the only one accredited program offered by Alexander College (BSc Business Administration with Accounting and Finance). The research centre in collaboration with staff members of the accredited program has already completed or works towards the completion on a number of funded research programs such as:

- Annual Research on Micro and Small Businesses in Larnaca (a research activity produced annually)
- Innovative Research on Public Procurement (the research was completed on May 2018 and results were announced on June 2018)
- Project PIN #prevention and #intervention (ongoing)

Alexander College, in view of its international collaborations and full adaptation to European Research Criteria and Strategies, as well as the forthcoming Institutional Evaluation, has closely involved with research and synergy with education. The college Board of Directors, following the suggestion of the Academic Council and the Internal Quality Assurance Committee, has adopted the Strategic Research Policy 2020 (<http://alexander.ac.cy/en/research-centre/>). The college Research Policy is promoted by the Alexander Research Centre and the Research Committee. Supports the academic community with materials and other motivations, diffuses the research culture in the academic and student community, prepares and participates with applications in competitions and programs while it aims to synergy primarily with Organizations of the wider region of Larnaca and Famagusta. In addition, the new structures (Internal Quality Assurance Committee, Research Committee, Alexander Research Centre) have ensured enrichment of courses and programs in the light of modern international developments and research results including research results of the Alexander Research Centre in Cyprus. In the framework of the Strategic Development and Research, Alexander College and the Alexander Research Centre are in talks to collaborate with Foreign Institutes including research collaboration with

academics and researchers. Additionally, talks on collaborations with educational institutions in Cyprus and abroad to attract research programs and funding are ongoing.

Furthermore, on April 2018 the new Research Policy Framework was issued in order to elaborate all programs offered at Alexander College, new and old, on various fields of study including Art and Design. One of the new policy framework targets is to improve the Research Work and Synergies with Teaching quality standard and indicators as well as to support and promote research spirit and activities amongst the college members. The Research Policy Framework can be found in Appendix 1.

- *"Urgently develop a procurement policy so that the teaching programmes are properly resourced with equipment and materials"*

The college has two computer labs. One of the computer labs is used mostly for online research and written assignment development and the second computer lab has design software including Corel Draw, Sketchup, Autodesk, ArchiCAD and Adobe CS6 Suite. Furthermore, students and staff have access or download educational licenced software using the college email address they receive upon registration.

The college management is aware that the proposed Bachelor of Design requires more resources than the previous franchise Design programs. The college management is committed, upon approval of the art and design programs by the Cyprus Agency of Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education, to invest further €20,000.00 on equipment necessary to improve the teaching and learning experience of students and staff.

The college has a print shop facility at the main building in room B3. Students and staff can either visit the shop to produce their work or send it through the email print@alexander.ac.cy. Relevant Print Shop information can be found on p. 26 of the Document: 200.1 submitted. Two permanent college staff members, Marina Nicola and George Pantelides, operate the Print Shop.

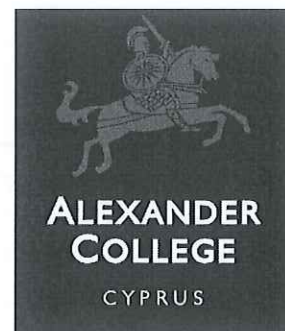
The college has a procurement process in place in order for staff members, both teaching and administrative, to request equipment, material, tools, books etc for purchase. The Request Form sample can be found in Appendix 2.

Over the years the college is collaborating with various industry related organizations in order to use their knowledge and industry expertise to support student learning experience. These outsourcing collaborations had a very positive impact over the years especially to students because they are aware of the latest industry technologies, equipment, market needs and trends. The collaborations have helped students to promote themselves, create professional relations and to find jobs once they graduate. Memorandums of Understanding between the college and industry collaborations can be found in Appendix 3.

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- *"Appoint an Erasmus officer and promote academic exchanges".*

The college received the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) in 2014 (Code CY LARNACA03). The college has an agreement with the University of the West of England according to the franchise agreement and also agreements on exchange programmes and work placement with academic institutions and organizations from abroad under the umbrella of Erasmus+.

The college has an Erasmus officer Mr. Panayiotis Elia p.elia@alexander.ac.cy located at the college main building in room B14. Even though all administration staff was present during the visiting day and a meeting was scheduled between them and the External committee, the committee found it not necessary to have the meeting.

- *"Enrich the collection in the Library and improve the loan policy."*

The college library has a stock of more than one thousand and four hundred (1400) book titles under the Design program and the pathways proposed. Full list of the book titles present in the college library can be found on the Application for Evaluation – Accreditation (Document: 200.1), from page 267 until 306. Also, can be found in Appendix 4. In relation to the comment on the loan policy the college management has decided to change the policy as of September 2018 from a single day loan to five consecutive days.

The college has agreed to participate on the Cyprus Academic Library Consortium (CALC). The library and teaching staff have received a trial access and are currently reviewing the various publishers suggested, in order to finalize the agreement.

- *"Extend opening hours in the studio".*

The studio facilities are open Monday to Friday from 8:00am until 20:00pm. On rare cases, and after student request, studio facilities open for students and staff during the weekends especially towards the end of the semester.

The comments addressed by the committee have been and will be in the future very helpful on the successful delivery of the program, although we would like to disagree on the comments made in relation to the graphic design pathway strength on p. 5. Existing Graphic Design students on the franchise program, using the existing infrastructure, have managed to succeed on various competitions they participated. A list of student achievements can be found in Appendix 5.

The college management is committed to further improve the teaching and learning experience on the proposed program upon accreditation, by taking actions in various levels including infrastructure, long-term teaching staff contacts and research synergy since the overall philosophy and needs are changing.

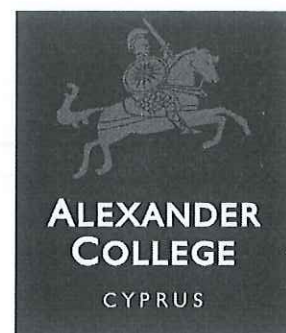

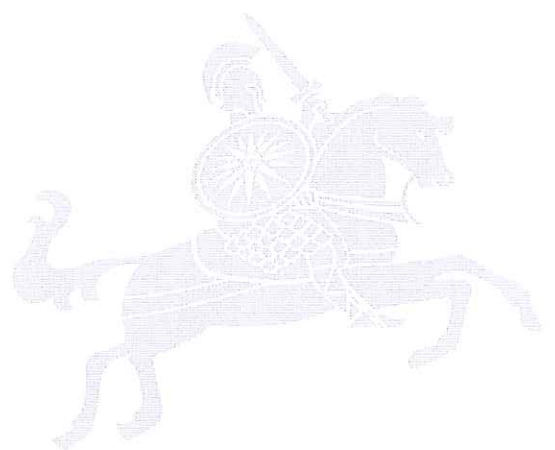

Alexander College's decision following the recommendation of the Internal Quality Assurance Committee and the Academic Council to Adopt Amendments to Alexander College's Research Policy

Research Excellence Framework

Alexander College recognizes the positive contribution of academic staff to continue progress and success. That is why the excellent contribution to research will be honored and rewarded.

In order to better support the synergy between research and teaching, Alexander College is committed to the best possible teaching quality in order to improve students' learning experience and thus drive higher student achievements, job opportunities and satisfaction.

To ensure a vibrant culture of research synergy with teaching, academic staff teach and conduct research at all levels, with the exception of staff who hold contracts for teaching only as they are not required to conduct research.

Research will be evaluated on the basis of its value.

All academic staff must demonstrate academic abilities and achievements. Their qualifications will be assessed in terms of the quality of their published and other creative work, the breadth and diversity of their research interests, their success in the field of independence and / or cooperation, their success in ensuring appropriate external support, success in the education and training of students in academic methods, their participation and leadership in professional associations and their record of publication in scientific journals and their prospects for success and academic achievements. Achievements can be categorized in the field of academic research, creative contribution to the professional field, or in the field of creative arts.

More specifically, the criteria relate to one or more of the followings:

- Development of individual research or leadership or contribution to a research team
- Development of methodology and appropriate techniques for each type of research development and support for research proposals and financial offers
- Dissemination and presentation of research findings in publications and conference proceedings

The Academic Staff will be evaluated annually by their colleagues in accordance with the procedures to assess their contribution, resulting in the recommendation to the Council for a wage increase based on the value of the contribution, including a possible exemption from teaching for staff who are actively engaged in research. Such an assessment will take into account the cumulative contribution of the faculty member using the following evidence:

- Developing original and independent research actions
- Publication in high-quality, peer-reviewed journals
- Locating and securing research funding
- Presenting at a high-level local or international conference
- Conducting research with empirically measurable criteria which is accessible and useful to , the wider public sector, industry or work.

Procedures

The evaluation of staff contributions and any possible salary increase will be the result of the assessment of the personal performance in relation to the peer review and in comparison, with the current salary of the person in relation to his/her peers.

Recommendations for wage increases will take into account the objective of reducing wage inequalities. Wage compression and other inequalities, including those resulting from variations in the level of value-based financing over time, may be taken into account when making salary increases.

The following procedure will be followed:

The Academic Director will examine the establishment of the field / program or department or the Research Committee and will promote his / her recommendation on value, salary or discharge from the teaching load to the Academic Committee. The Commission will forward its suggestion to the Council and the Director for a final decision.

In addition to the Research Excellence Program that includes the annual assessment of permanent staff (discharge and reward), the Academic Council decides and modifies the existing regulations regarding Research at Alexander College based on the following:

The funding sources of the Academic Staff consist of funding from:

- a) Funding from own resources (internal) of the College.
- b) External funding from third party funds.
- c) Co-funding of Research

Philosophy of cost eligibility

The Research Activity covers the following categories for cost eligibility of a Research Activity:

- Developing independent and original research activities.
- Publications in high quality and peer-reviewed journals or participation in a similar quality journal.
- Identifying sources of funding for research and funding success.
- Proof of Judgment for high quality journals and / or evidence of presence at major local and international conferences.
- Effect of research.

A. Funding from Own Resources

Funding from own resources concerns Internal Research Projects and Activities funded exclusively from the budget of Alexander College or Alexander Research Center. The funding is decided by the Board of Directors of the Institution after the recommendation of the Research Committee. A separate fund is drawn up by the Alexander Research Center according to its own decisions and statutes. For the purpose of uniformly addressing research and research activity, the allocation is done according to the current Alexander College policy, in accordance with the decisions of the Research Committee and the Board of Directors of Alexander Research Center. Alexander College's policy involves conducting scientific research and publicize its results as a central pillar of the mission of a Higher Education Foundation.

The fund covers research activity and programs and does not exceed € 1,500 per year for each faculty member (excluding disposable supplies where there is special provision).

- **Research activities**

To achieve this goal, research activities and research projects will be funded by both young and well-established researchers but cannot be funded by other sources of funding.

Funding research inputs, required to participate in a research activity or research project, as well as "research results" (such as awards for the publication of articles in prestigious journals) will be funded by specific criteria such as (list of journals of high prestige, categorization, etc.).

- **Costs Eligibility**

1. Researchers' remuneration - scientific assistant and research assistants (research assistants, postgraduate students). The remuneration of the scientific officer may not exceed 30% of the total budget.
2. Travel expenses for participation in research collaborations with other Institutions (covering the expenses of the faculty member of Alexander College or the expenses of associate researchers-visitors). [Cost of Travel / Hotel Cost / Daily Compensation].

3. Participation costs for presenting work at a major international conference [Registration Fee / Travel Cost / Hotel Cost / Daily Compensation]. Eligible congresses, are annual conferences of international or European academic associations or conferences of similar standing.
4. Purchase of software and other consumables not covered by other sources of funding
5. Access to databases not covered by other sources of funding
6. Publication costs
7. Proof Judge for high quality journals and / or evidence of attendance at major local and international conferences
8. Purchase of books or scientific journals or articles (from electronic journals) or subscriptions to scientific journals.
9. Operating costs (postal or bank charges) or technical support costs required to implement the project.

Project costs that are not disbursed and not transferred to the next year are added to Alexander College's budget for the following year.

- **Opening Funding**

Introductory funding is institutionalized as an investment in new members of academic staff. The aim is to be able to develop the necessary basic research infrastructure and be productive in their research aspirations. This mechanism will help to make the members of the Academic Staff capable of basic and applied research and then compete in demanding external funding. Selection is made by the Research Committee, following an evaluation of a relevant application and a personal interview of the prospective academic.

B. Co – funding:

Co – funding concerns Research Programs where external funding does not cover all of the Program's funding. These programs require part of the funding from Alexander College's internal budget funds.

C. ExternalFunding:

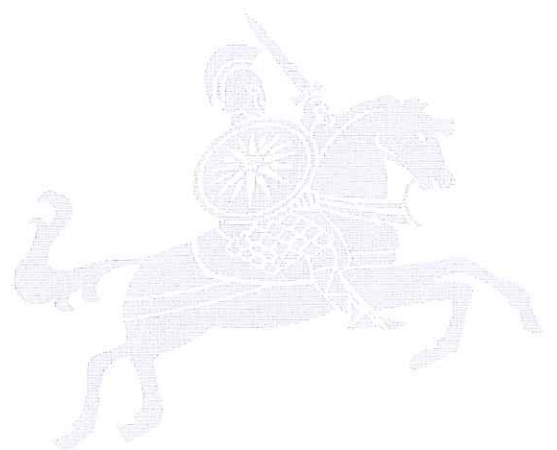
External Funding deals with External and Internal Research Programs fully funded by external sources. These include European and International Programs and Research Projects of the Research Promotion Foundation

Consumables

Costs for consumables and small equipment are submitted with requests up to a maximum of € 500 to the Research Committee or the Research Center, indicatively from the previous year and officially at the beginning of the year

For unpredictable requests that will not exceed € 500, the Research Committee, the Deputy Chairman, the Director and the Financial Manager of the Alexander Research Center, are authorized to approve them without an application from previous year.
