

STUDENT MOBILITY AND CONTINUATION AGREEMENT

This Student Mobility and Continuation Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into between:

Neapolis University Pafos (NUP), Cyprus, and
[Student Full Name], holder of Passport/ID No. [...], enrolled in the joint English-taught **Joint Integrated Master in Product Design Engineering with the University of Western Macedonia (English/Conventional) (5 years/300 ECTS)** or **“Joint BSc in Product Design Engineering with the University of Western Macedonia (English/Conventional) (4 years/240 ECTS)** (the "Programme"), offered in jointly with the **University of Western Macedonia (UWM)**, Greece.

1. Purpose of the Agreement

The purpose of this Agreement is to formally confirm the Student's understanding and acceptance that the Programme is jointly delivered by NUP and UWM, and that the place of study changes after the completion of the first two (2) academic years.

2. Structure of the Programme

1. The Student acknowledges that:
 - Years 1 and 2 of the Programme are delivered at **Neapolis University Pafos**, Cyprus.
 - Years 3, 4 and 5 of the Programme are delivered at the **University of Western Macedonia**, Kozani, Greece.
2. Successful progression to the third year is subject to the completion of all academic requirements of the first two years, in accordance with the Programme Regulations.

3. Obligation to Transfer

1. By signing this Agreement, the Student **explicitly agrees and commits** to physically relocate and continue their studies at the University of Western Macedonia from the beginning of the third (3rd) academic year.
2. The Student understands that failure or refusal to transfer to UWM without an approved and documented exceptional reason may result in:
 - Inability to continue the Programme, and/or
 - Termination of enrolment in the joint Programme.

4. Student Responsibilities

The Student agrees to:

1. Comply with all academic, administrative and disciplinary regulations of both Institutions.
2. Take responsibility for:
 - Visa and residence permit arrangements (where applicable),
 - Travel, accommodation and living expenses in Kozani, Greece.
3. Participate in all orientation and registration and induction procedures required by NUP and UWM prior to the commencement of Year 3.

5. Institutional Support

1. NUP and UWM commit to providing timely information regarding:
 - Academic transition procedures,
 - Registration and enrolment at UWM,
 - Student support services and accommodation guidance in Kozani.
2. The Universities will cooperate to ensure academic continuity and recognition of completed coursework.

6. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Republic of Cyprus as applicable to Joint academic Study Programmes.

7. Final Provisions

1. This Agreement forms an integral part of the Student's enrolment documentation.
2. Signing this Agreement is a **mandatory condition** for participation in the joint Programme.
3. Any amendments must be made in writing and approved by both Universities.
