1. Remarks on the CYQAA Final Report

The CYQAA Final Report, during its 53rd summit on the 12th May, 2020, and after our Department's feedback on the External Evaluation Committee's reports, proceeded to the accreditation of the following program:

In Greek:

Μουσική (4 έτη, 240 ECTS, Πτυχίο)

In English:

Music (4 years, 240 ECTS, Bachelor of Music)

Following the CYQAA report, our University was requested to proceed to the following actions by 31st December 2020:

- 1. Review all aspects of instrumental provision and acquire quality instruments to conform to international standards.
- 2. Acquire further online databases: RILM, JStor, RISM, MGG, to accompany Proquest, the Naxos Music Library, Groveonline, and other existing resources.

In addition, the Agency requires the Institution to attract Visiting Faculty who will be engaged with teaching through an entire semester in order for the programme to become more visible internationally, and will give the opportunity to its students to broaden their horizons and knowledge.

2. Institution's Response

Regarding the above, the University has proceeded into taking action as follows:

- Purchased two pianos, both Ritmüller, and specifically one grand (GP160) and one upright (UP121). two pianos will enrich our existing instrumental depository, and will also facilitate the performance of two-piano ensemble work in the concert hall of the university, since one of them will be placed in the Cultural Centre where concerts take place.
- 2. The library has proceeded into the acquisition of:
 - RILM Abstracts of Music Literature with Full Text and
 - RILM Music Encyclopaedias

Regarding JSTOR: this will be added through the Cyprus Academic Libraries Consortium (CALC) at a later stage, as the database's acquisition is part of an ongoing negotiation on a national level concerning all private and public universities in Cyprus which belong to CALC. According to CALC's policy, one party cannot proceed with the acquisition of a subscription – as is the case with JSTOR – if there is an expressed interest from other universities as well, since it is up to the Consortium to engage in negotiations with the subscriber to reach an agreement on a national level.

Moreover, MGG is available to be searched via EBSCO Discovery Service (EDS). Once an institution subscribes to MGG from RILM, it is possible to access MGG through RILM's platform Egret and EDS. Since our university library offers EDS, MGG could be visible and accessible via EDS.

It should be noted, nevertheless, that so far, the university has subscriptions to approximately 650 full-text music journals. (See Appendix 1-Databases)

3. The attraction of visiting professors from abroad has not materialised, due to the Covid-19 restrictions in travelling and the fact that most of the courses are currently being taught online following guidelines from the Government of Cyprus. Under these circumstances, the possibility of hosting a visiting professor at the university has proved unrealistic. However, with the crisis of the pandemic hopefully nearing its end, we will be able to host visiting professors on campus who will contribute to the specializations of the new programs.

C. Other institutional action taken towards the implementation of ESG aiming at the improvement of the institution / department / programme of study.

Based on the External Evaluation Committee's reports, as well as the CYQAA's final report, and in order to improve our department and programmes of study, we have proceeded into supplementary actions in order to further update our library resources and diversify our teaching personnel.

In particular, our department has proceeded with ordering a number of books recently published in Europe and authored by European researchers. (See Appendix 2-Music books)

Moreover, we have proceeded to signing a Memorandum of Understanding agreement with the Jerusalem Academy of Music and Dance, and we will proceed into offering a joint undergraduate module in the Spring Semester 2021.
