2. Institution's Response

We have implemented the recommendation to increase the number of permanent, qualified academic staff within the programme, who are involved in both teaching and research, as it can be seen in Table 3 and Table 4 below.

The distribution of teaching hours between full-time permanent academic staff and part-time collaborative academic staff is as follows:

- 73% of teaching hours are delivered by full-time Permanent Academic Staff
- 27% of teaching hours are delivered by part-time Collaborative Academic Staff
