Also, a few of our recommendations have been pointed out in the response, that they will take into account. The only element we would have liked to see in the response is the inclusion (at least the discussion/reflection) of the possibility to discuss internally the percentage of continuous assessment and final exams, but we conceder this optional. Several appropriate actions to our recommendations are described in the response.
