The above link is according to the ETEK regulations, is posted on the web page of ETEK and anybody can find out the minimum requirements to be register a Civil Engineer Member of ETEK.

I strongly believe that there should be revision of the curriculum of the Programme so the graduates will be able to be members of ETEK.

According to these, I suggest two lessons from the Electives Proposal from the Application form of the Programme to be transferred at the Compulsory List. To be more specific the CIVE 412, Steel Design and the CIVE 616 Earthquake Design should be added to the compulsory list so as the minimum requirements of the ETEK be covered.

In addition, at the Part III (link data) shows the subjects of the laboratories that students should attend and at least two of these subjects are the minimum requirements.

From the Part II, 8 more lessons should be at the Elective list at the education Programme.

At the Part II, there are 6 different subject categories, for example the ‘ A ’ is Structural Engineering. If a student wants to become specialises on this subject should have minimum 8 elective lessons from this category, from “B” category the same and so on.

On the attached list I correlate the Compulsory list of the minimum requirements of ETEK with the list of the recommended courses of the Program
