This Final Report was prepared on the basis of Article (20) (2)(f)(i) of the "Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education and the Establishment and Operation of an Agency on Related Matters Laws" of 2015 to 2019 [N.136 (I)/2015 to N.35 (I)/2019].

#### THE PROCEDURE:

On 27 November 2019, the legal representative of the Higher Education Institution European University Cyprus submitted an application (Doc. 200.1), based on Article (17) of the "Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education and the Establishment and Operation of an Agency on Related Matters Laws" of 2015 to 2019, for the evaluation-accreditation of the programme of study:

IN GREEK: Δημόσια Υγεία (3 έτη, 180 ECTS, Διδακτορικό)

IN ENGLISH: Public Health (3 years, 180 ECTS, PhD)

This application is registered in the file with the reference number: 07.14.327.074

In the framework of competences conferred on it by the relevant legislation, the Council of the Agency has constituted an External Evaluation Committee (EEC) which, after initially examining the institution's application for programme evaluation and accreditation, performed an on-site visit at the institution on 6 February 2020

The EEC met with the head of the institution, the head of the relevant department, the programme's coordinator, members of the academic staff, members of the administrative staff, students and/or their representatives and the Internal Quality Assurance Committee.

Additionally, the EEC examined the institution's facilities (library, computer labs, labs, teaching classes, research infrastructures, etc.), various documents presented and/or requested by the EEC, the School's/ Faculty's structure and the programme's position in it, the CVs of the teaching staff and their relationship to the institution as teachers in regard to any other duties and teaching in other programmes of study.

The EEC has documented its findings and recommendations and drew up the External Evaluation Report in the Doc. 300.3.1/1.

#### **CYQAA Council's Decision**

The Council of the Cyprus Agency of Quality Assurance and Accreditation of Higher Education, during its 55<sup>th</sup> Summit on 6 July 2020, on the basis of Article 20 (2)(f) (ii) of the "Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education and the Establishment and Operation of an Agency on Related Matters Laws" of 2015 to 2019 [N.136 (I)/2015 to N.35 (I)/2019], and on the basis of the suggestions of the External Evaluation Committee, the comments of the institution on the report and the feedback from the External Evaluation Committee, **decided that the programme is accredited to be delivered in Greek and English.** 

The Agency requires the Institution, within six months and no later than December 2020, to further support the following:

- Recruit permanent academic staff who will integrate the programme of study in the field of Public Health. To appoint and send to the Agency the CV of the academic coordinator in the field of Public Health.
- Provide evidence on the research orientation of the programme of study, the synergy of research with teaching and students' involvement in research.
- Provide evidence on the actions taken with regard to staff training and visiting professorship.
- Provide evidence that research and consequently publication activities focus on public health challenges.
- Provide evidence on how the institution supports the academic staff who is involved in research.

The Agency reminds you that the Institution needs to immediately publish on the programme's website, the information regarding the full-time and visitor academics.

It is noted that the programme's duration is from 3 to 8 years and corresponds to 180 ECTS if the candidate holds a master's degree and 240 ECTS if not.

The Agency is entitled to request from the Institution evidence and data confirming that the Institution employs permanent academic staff, including evidence of social insurance payments made by the employer.

It is also noted that the contemporary global higher education environment requires that the provision of programmes and the award of academic degrees meet the strictest quality criteria. These criteria refer to an academic environment that conducts, promotes and utilizes research in teaching. Research culture and not just information on contemporary research data is essential in order to offer qualitative graduate and postgraduate programmes.

The current accreditation begins in the Winter semester of the academic year 2020 – 2021 and ceases to be in effect at the end of the Spring semester of the academic year 2024 – 2025.

On the basis of Article (4) of the relevant Legislation, it is noted that "the above accreditation is valid for the period provided by the provisions of the Law and is repeated every five (5) years and that the procedure starts at the request of the institution which must, and shall be submitted at least sixteen (16) months before the expiry of the previous accreditation".

Additionally, on the basis of Article (17) (3) (f) during the period of validity of the Accreditation, the Agency acting of its own motion, may examine whether the criteria continue to be met and if they are not met, then the Agency shall revoke the Accreditation, and immediately inform the institution concerned.
