RE (Required Elective): There are three Required Electives in Linguistics (LALI-274, LALI-372, LALI-491) and three in Literature (LALI-335, LALI-482, LALI-442) which is an opportunity for the student to specialize in one of the fields. They need to do one of the "packages" of three, but over and above, they can take any other elective offered in the two fields during their studies. In addition, the students have to choose either Thesis (LALI-495) or Practicum (LALI-498).
